Kate landed the role by applying through LinkedIn and proactively reaching out to contacts she had built through a prior internship with the NJ Devils Youth Foundation. Each morning, she kicked off the day by summarizing recent sports marketing articles for her team. Her daily tasks included organizing sponsor databases or updating Excel spreadsheets. She would also join in on calls with sponsors throughout the day as her team had to do yearly recaps with all club partners during the NHL off-season.

One of the biggest takeaways from her experience was the value of taking advantage of company resources and building relationships with people across departments regardless of whether their roles aligned with her exact career goals. She also emphasized the importance of self-advocacy, asking questions and seeking clarity when unsure about tasks assigned to her helped her grow and contribute more confidently.
